What is an "End of Life" determination?

After a warranty ends, the manufacturer cannot obtain parts (electrodes/pads, batteries, etc.) for older defibrillators and therefore cannot adequately support maintenance, "End of Life" determination is issued. This is a result of technology changes and improvements to design or usability.

We will be taking resident donations in the Activities office toward the purchase of new ones over the next few weeks, as we want to replace these sooner than later. Funds from the Christmas Silent Auction that are not designated to a specific group, ie General fund will be directed toward new AEDs.
