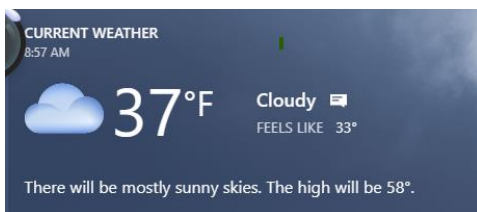




Activity News December 14, 2022
