



## Activities NewsBlast Jan 13, 2023

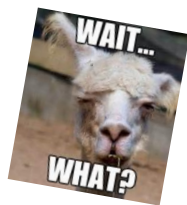


**When is Friday the 13th?** UMMMM...this is an actual question??? Uhh last I checked I was on Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>.
