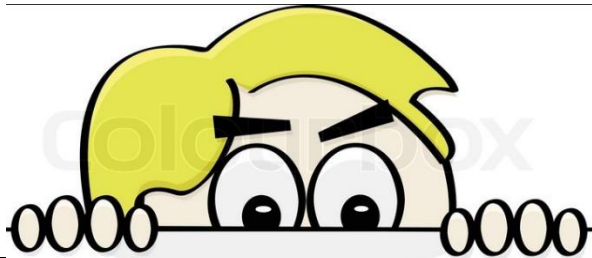
**DIFFERENCE BETWEEN "NEXT FRIDAY"

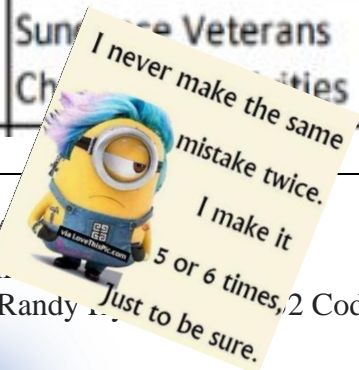
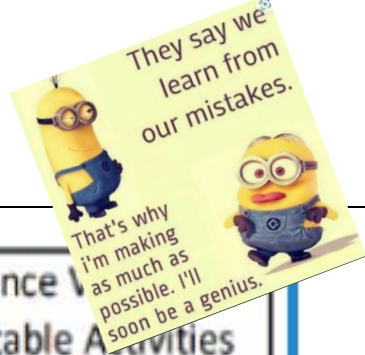

We have a new opportunity to come together as a community. In 2018 the residents of the park bought two AED units—one was placed in the laundry room at SD1 and another in the ladies restroom at Pool 2. Unfortunately, these AEDs are outdated and need to be replaced,

What is an “End of Life” determination? After a warranty ends, the manufacturer cannot obtain parts (electrodes/pads, batteries, etc.) for older defibrillators and therefore cannot adequately support maintenance. “End of Life” determination is issued. This is a result of technology changes and improvements to design or usability.

We are taking resident donations in the Activities office toward the purchase of new ones over the next few weeks, as we want to replace these sooner than later. Funds from the Christmas Silent Auction that were not designated to a specific group, ie General fund have been directed toward new AEDs, RAISING APPROXIMATELY \$400.
