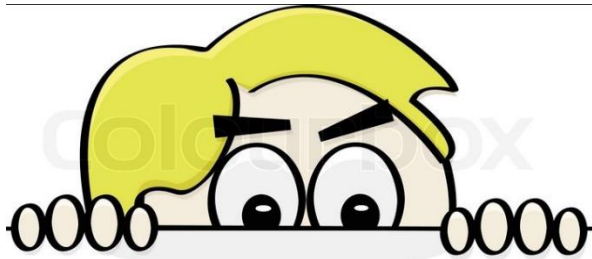




## Activities NewsBlast February 17, 2023
