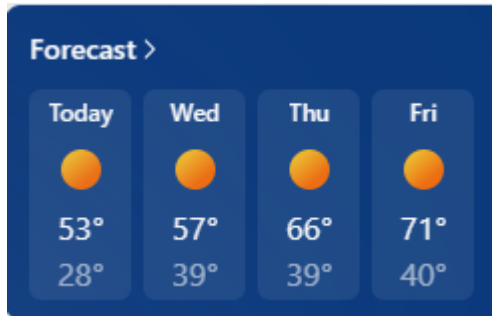




Activity's News Blast , February 15th, 2023

Let's see what's in store for you **TOMORROW:**

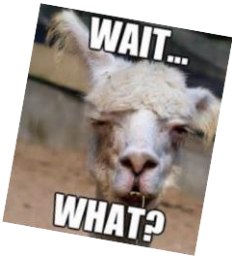
- MASA lunch seminar at 10:30 in the HW
