Let's see what's in store for you **TOMORROW: February 9th**

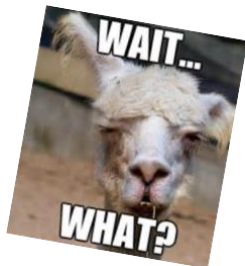
