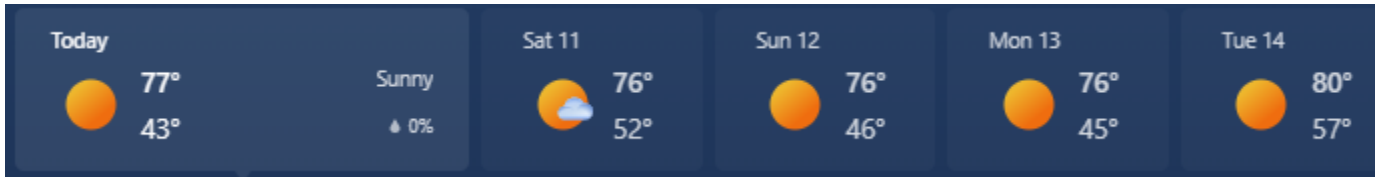




## Activities NewsBlast Mar 10, 2023

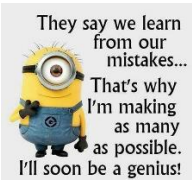
## END OF SEASON REMINDERS
