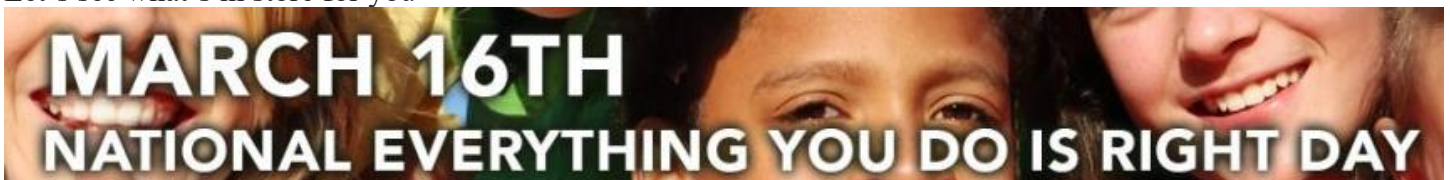

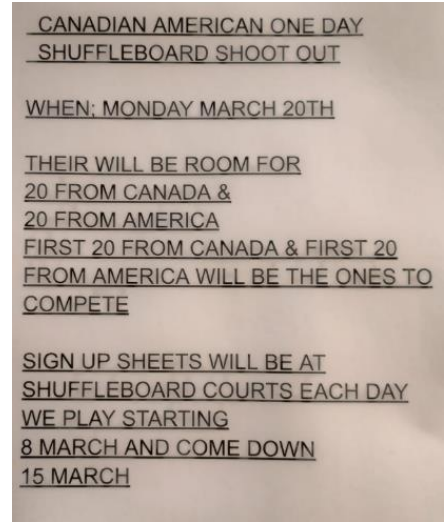

We need more from Canada to sign up for the shuffleboard Can Am shoot out it will be a great time with friendly competition.

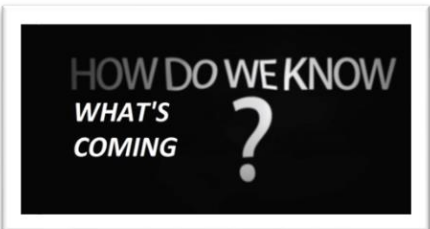
