- USPS MAIL:
- **SD1 and SD3** USPS mail is picked up at the post office and placed in your mailbox in the mailroom of the SD1 main complex.
- **SD2** mail is delivered by USPS to your mailbox located in front of the Ranch House. **The Buttes** mail is delivered by USPS to your mailbox located in the Buttes compound.
- PACKAGE DELIVERY (Amazon, Fed EX. UPS) is delivered directly to your site. The Activities Office, Main Office nor Mailroom accepts packages.
- Packages and USPS mail must be dropped at the mailroom prior to 9:30 a.m.
- Outgoing USPS Mail can be sent from the mailroom by dropping in the drop box located in the "inside" hallway between the Main Office and mailroom. "IN Park" mail between residents for only SD1 and SD3 can be dropped in the "Park" drop box and will be placed in resident box. The mailroom DOES NOT deliver to SD2 or The Buttes.

Wash Permits are needed for residents in SD1 and can be purchased from the Activities office. Permits need to be posted when cleaning vehicles, decks, screens, park models, etc.

Group Highlights

Golf Scramble - Thursday golf scramble, at the Dave White Golf Course. Nine-hole course (fee will be posted on sign-up sheet) Tee off time is 1pm be at the course by 12:30. You need to sign up for the current week by Saturday afternoon at 2 PM. Sign-up for the following week begins at 8:30 am. Monday mornings in the Activities Office. Hardanger - Hardanger is Norwegian charted embroidery worked over counted thread material. That's what we're called but we welcome all working on charted embroidery (counted cross stitch, whitework, smocking and more) or any other craft in a quiet atmosphere for those needing to concentrate on a pattern. We meet on Tuesdays, from 1:00 to 3:00, in the Hangout Room. There is always help and friendship available.

Poker -- On **Sunday afternoon** the game is Hold'em and is played from 4:30 to 7pm in the Gambling Room. The buy in is \$2 and you receive 40 chips worth 1 nickel each. Blinds are 5 and 10c. If we have more than 10 players, we split into two tables. It's a friendly game with no raise pre-flop and the max raise is 5 chips. Limit 3 raises and no check/raise. If you run out of chips, you can always buy more from those that took yours.

There is also a Hold'em tournament played from 6-10pm in the Hangout Room. The buy in is \$5 and rebuys are allowed. On **Tuesdays and Thursdays**, the game is Dealers Choice and is played from 6 to 9pm in the Hangout Room. Dealer's Choice means the dealer can play whatever game he/she wants – the basic rules are max bet is 25c with max 3 raises and no wild cards are allowed. This is a nickel, dime, quarter game played with actual nickels, dimes and quarters – change is usually available if needed. In order to make it easy to keep track of and avoid arguments, the dealer antes 25c which covers the other players regardless of the number of players. Many of the games played are a Hi/Lo split pot. Ohama H/L is a good example and a popular game. 5 card draw and 7 card stud are also popular games. All hands are played to the best 5 cards, regardless of how many cards you are looking at. (In Hold'em, you are looking at 7 cards)

We rarely have more than 8 players show up to play. We're hoping we can get lots of players this year, there has to be more than 8 poker players! Come join the Poker players......
