



Walk Exercise--Join Kathy and Jim at 9 AM (M/W/TH/F) and get your "gait" going. Walking is one of the main gaits of terrestrial locomotion among legged animals. Walking is typically slower than running and other gaits. Walking is defined by an 'inverted pendulum' gait in which the body vaults over the stiff limb or limbs with each step. This applies regardless of the usable number of limbs—even arthropods, with six, eight, or more limbs, walk. In humans, walking has health benefits including improved mental health and reduced risk of cardiovascular disease and death.

Better flexibility may:

- Improve your performance in physical activities

RULES AND COMMON SENSE

Adults tend to resent rules – especially rules in the 55+ community. Have you, or the people around you, ever thought these things:

"Why can't they trust us?" "Do they think we're stupid or something!" "Isn't that just common sense?" The reality is that not everyone has the same level of common sense or awareness of consequences. In a perfect world, we'd all live with integrity, honesty, safety, and concern for the well-being of our neighbors. But you don't have to look far to find examples where this hasn't happened? People race thru stop signs, fill the dumpsters with furniture and large items, stack the trash to see how high they can go, don't clean up after their dog, walk around without their shirts or cover-ups, play their music too loud, park in no parking areas, harass and blame others, always look for fault.

Why We Have Rules

Unfortunately, some people take advantage of situations for their benefit. That's why rules are necessary. It's also why you need to understand why the rules are there and what they protect. When you appreciate this, you can help yourself – and others – follow the rules and build more harmony in the community.

The dog parks are open 24-7, unfortunately the people who live next to the dog parks like to sleep. Keeping that in mind please close the gates quietly and gently place the lids back on the "poop" cans when visiting the dog park late at night or in the early morning hours.

Some of you don't use the dog parks instead walking your dog along the canal, thru the storage areas or down the street, and that's OK as long as you **carry a** "poop" bag\, AND you have them on a leash at all times. Please be a respectful pet owner and neighbor.

Don't you just hate it when people invade your privacy and walk between your park model and the neighbors. Don't be that person!! use the street and walk around.

Definition of 'prohibit'. If a rule or someone in authority prohibits something, they forbid it or make it illegalwe have rule that are prohibit certain activities unless pre-approved in writing by the Management:

- Yard or carport sales, except for Community Wide sales approved by Management (and solely for disposal of tenant's personal and not for resale or commercial purposes.
- Reporting or filing frivolous or unjustified complaints.
- Appliances and furniture other than commercially manufactured outdoor furniture.

Seasonal Tenants and Extended Absences—Periodic or seasonal and those who will be absent from the community for more than 30 days, must notify the Management office upon arrival and departure, arrange for the care of their home and lot during absences, and provide the name and phone # of their caretaker.

Guests and visitors are subject to the rules and shall not be in the community or use community facilities without their host present. ID badges are available in the activities office and must be worn by guests and visitors while in the community and returned at the end of their visit.
