- **HIKING**, is going to the Hieroglyphic Trail in the Superstition Mtns. We will meet by the activity office at 8 am. It is roughly 60 miles and just under 1.5 hours to the trailhead. This is a roughly 3-mile hike with some elevation change. Should be good for less experienced hikers. Hikers should have proper hiking shoes as the Arizona rocks can be slippery. Water, sunscreen, hats and an energy snack are suggested. Riders will be asked share cost of gas \$5 to the driver.

- **Pickleball News and Current Schedule**, Attention Pickleball Players. Pickleball Happy Hour, Thursday Dec 7th @ 4PM.
 - **Organized play will begin on Wednesday, December 6.** Organized play will consist of round robins, ladders and paddle-up/challenge courts, each on a different day. Most organized play consists of 6 or 7 games. Watch your "in-box" if you have completed your waiver, or check at the office for printed schedules. Most organized play will begin at 9 AM. Sign-up is required for round robins and ladder play. Round robin sign-up is on the morning of the play. Ladder sign-ups will be posted on Mondays starting December 4.

For those of you who may be new to structured pickleball, we are providing a brief explanation of the organized play options:

- **Round robin:** A structured form of play that mixes up the opponents for each game. During the Round Robin session, you will play a number of games, each potentially with a different partner and against a different pair of opponents. Round robins require sign-in
 - **Mixed partner round robin:** A round robin where all games are played with the same partner. A "team" must consist of one male and one female. Start recruiting your partners now.
 - **Ladder:** Ladder play separates individuals by level. Each player will have a starting position on the ladder to begin the season. Following the first three games, the highest scoring player moves up and the lowest scoring player moves down one court. Three additional games are played. Scores are tallied and entered into a software program with the goal of keeping players of somewhat equal level together.
 - **Paddle-up:** An open-play format that mixes players up by win or lose for each game. Paddles are placed into either a rack marked "G" for winners (gold) or "S" for challengers (silver). Players split with their previous partner so new teams are formed for each game.
- Challenge court(s):** 4 players take a court to play. The winners stay on the court together. Other players can "challenge" in to take on the winners.

All players are required to sign a waiver form. If you haven't yet filled out the waiver, they are available at the courts, and must be accompanied with \$10.00 per player. The waivers can be dropped off to Doug Myers at Sundance 3, **Lot 825**. The \$10.00 is used for balls, nets, and other supplies as required.

- If you have any questions about pickleball, stop up at the courts any morning and someone will be there to assist you.
