The Registration guest list is missing your name. All of those returning for the season in SD 1, 2 or 3 as well as Park Model rental tenants need to check into the office and let them know you're on site --- Periodic or seasonal tenants, and those who will be absent from the community for more than 30 days, must notify the Management office upon arrival and departure, arrange for the care of their home and lot during absences, and provide the name and phone # of their caretaker.
