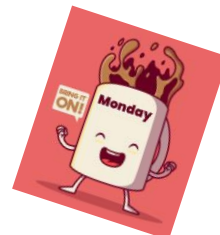

- **USPS MAIL:**
 - **SD1 and SD3** USPS mail is picked up at the post office and placed in your mailbox in the mailroom of the SD1 main complex.
 - **SD2** mail and **The Buttes** mail is delivered by USPS to your mailbox
 - **PACKAGE DELIVERY** (Amazon, Fed EX. UPS) is delivered directly to your site. When ordering give additional delivery instructions and directions if available to include the name of your street,
 - The Activities Office, Main Office nor Mailroom accepts packages.
 - **Packages and USPS** mail must be dropped at the mailroom prior to 9:30 a.m.
 - **Outgoing USPS Mail** can be sent from the mailroom by dropping in the drop box located in the “inside” hallway between the Main Office and mailroom. “IN Park” mail between residents for only SD1 and SD3 can be dropped in the “Park” drop box and will be placed in resident box. The mailroom DOES NOT deliver to SD2 or The Buttes.



The Registration guest list is missing your name. All of those returning for the season in SD 1, 2 or 3 as well as Park Model rental tenants need to check into the office and let them know you're on site --- Periodic or seasonal tenants, and those who will be absent from the community for more than 30 days, must notify the Management office upon arrival and departure, arrange for the care of their home and lot during absences, and provide the name and phone # of their caretaker. **NOT JUST A SUGGESTION**

Guests, visitors and are subject to the rules and shall not be in the community or use community facilities without their host present. ID badges are available in the activities office and must be worn by guests and visitors while in the community and returned at the end of their visit.

VEHICLES AND PARKING

Per Sundance1 LLC rules and regulations on page 3:

Only one recreational vehicle and two passenger vehicles shall be parked on any one lot.

One ATV or two motorcycles may be parked in place of a passenger vehicle.

Vehicles prohibited from storage on a lot or streets include:

Cargo and utility trailers and car dollies

Boat and boat trailers

Any vehicle not expressly designed for normal resident transportation. Such vehicles must be placed in storage area.

ALL VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED ON THE PATIO SIDE OF YOUR SITE UNDER THE AWNING. GOLF CARTS OR VEHICLES ARE NOT TO BE PARKED ON GRAVEL. GOLF CARTS CAN BE PARKED ON PAVERS OR CONCRETE PAD. EXCEPTIONS MUST BE APPROVED.
