VOLUNTEER TODAY

Will you be a new "light bulb" and help keep the "lights" burning, going into the 2024-25 season, talk to the room and activity coordinators, and activity office to see how can you help? It's been 25 years since the park opened, during that time volunteers came forward to schedule games and activities that interested them and invited their friends and neighbors. People stepped in to run the ceramics shop, stained glass, lapidary, computer room, start a photo club, Desert Theater, Jammers, started a Church, and Veterans Club, RC race club, Pickleball, shuffleboard, bible studies, Golf scramble, organized holiday events and potlucks, helped with preparation and clean-up, bingo, swim exercise, walking group, and stretch exercise, collected books and started a library. JUST TO NAME A FEW. This year we have approximately 198 different activities including but not limited to (20+ state or group potlucks, cards/games, group/park meetings & seminars, dances, & entertainment.) These activities are run by volunteers. Unfortunately, those who started many of these activities are burning out....you know the analogy of a burned-out light bulb? When one burns out, they all burn out at the same time. The problem we have now is we can't find enough new "light bulbs" to replace those that are burning out. Will you be a new "light bulb" and help keep the "lights" burning, going into the 2024-25 season

TAIKE RESPONSIBILTY

We have rules that will keep the park clean and safe for all residents and visitors, emergencies should be reported to the office or maintenance, after 5:00pm please call 520-426-9662, however they can't be in every corner of the park 24-7 and can only do so much to enforce the rules. Requests and/or complaints must be in writing with legible name, site # and signature to be considered. If you feel management or staff is not taking appropriate action or is the source of the problem, you may forward your complaint directly to the Town Council by completing a form in Activities or to the owner of the resort at 1703 N. Thornton Rd.
