bottom of the shoes will end up in our sparkling pools and could possibly damage the filtering equipment. PLEASE DO NOT WEAR STREET FLIP FLOPS AND SANDALS IN THE POOL.

- ALWAYS Shower and rinse off body oils and soap residue before entering the pool both pools have outdoor showers, (Not to be used for personal hygiene yes, we've seen that too!) (2)
- Bathing attire needs to be thoroughly rinsed well after being washed as soap will collect in the fabric and will end up in the pool and especially in the hot tubs. (HMMM didn't know this....) This in turn requires additional maintenance to the hot tub.
- No glass containers in or around the fenced area of patio, pool deck or hot tub
