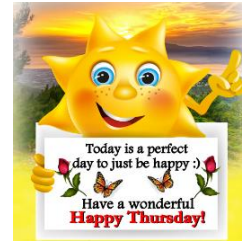

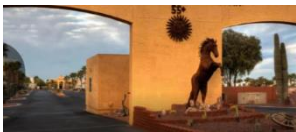

take over! The hike will be to Hackberry Springs Loop near Lost Dutchman State Park. This will be followed by a drive up to Tortilla Flats to explore and have lunch. The hike is 3.7 miles and 515 feet of elevation. It has some steeper hills with loose rocks and stepping thru creek beds with rocks so has a few more technical aspects. Very little shade. It may not be appropriate for those with less experience on Az trails. The drive is 60 miles, 1.2 hours traveling and the final 2.5 miles is a hard pack road. Sign up in activities by Monday @ noon for Tuesday hikes. We will meet by the activity office at 7:45 at leaving at 8am. Hikers should have proper hiking shoes as the Arizona rocks can be slippery. Water, sunscreen, hats and an energy snack are suggested.
