Group Highlights

GEO Caching-- Geocaching is an outdoor recreational activity, in which participants use a Global Positioning System (GPS) receiver or mobile device and other navigational techniques to hide and seek containers, called geocaches or caches, at specific locations marked by coordinates all over the world. The first geocache was placed in 2000, and by 2023 there were over 3 million active. There are 552 geocaches around Casa Grande. Geo Cache events will be announced as they are scheduled.

Gourd Crafting --We all buy the little gourds from the grocery store. We are drawn to their unique shapes and sizes. Perhaps you've picked up a few for Halloween crafts or to decorate your Thanksgiving table. What you might not have realized is that gourds aren't just for decoration. Our Gourd Shop will show you the **creative things to do with gourds** and open your eyes to all the possibilities. Monitors will be there to help you clean them, carve them, and decorate them. Stop by the Gourd shop when they open to discuss the many possibilities of Gourd Crafting.

Bridge -- Bridge is a trick-taking card game played by four players in two teams. It is one of the most popular and enduring card games in the world, known for its complexity and strategic depth. The objective of bridge is to score points by winning tricks and fulfilling the contract bid by one of the players. Our Bridge group meets twice weekly on Sundays and Fridays in the Gambling Room at 7 PM. They also have a "Beginner Bridge Play" and will teach you on Sunday evenings in the Gambling Room at 7 PM.

Card Bingo -- or Bango is a fun and simple card game similar to traditional bingo but played with a standard deck of playing cards. It can be played with 2 or more players. The objective is to be the first player to flip over all of your dealt cards by matching them to cards revealed from a separate deck. Linda Wright the coordinator of our Card Bingo Group has some interesting variations, and she loves to bake for you. We recently had over 40 people show up to play. Join them for this fun easy to learn, quick paced game on Wednesday evenings at the Buttes Clubhouse at 6:30 PM. come early to get set-up and get your treats. (doors open at 6 o'clock)

MANDALA DOT ART -- For those of you new to Sundance, her name is Pam Pringle and she is the mandala dot art instructor. Her scheduled day in the ART BARN is Friday, so you will see her classes scheduled on that day. Here is how the process works: She develops her list of classes, dates, and times month by month. The classes are posted in the Activities office and are available on or around the 1st day of each month. For example, her schedule of classes for November will be posted on Friday, November 1st. If past experience remains true, the classes fill up quickly (as the Art Barn only holds a set # of individuals comfortably), so it will be important to check with the Activities office at the beginning of the month to make sure that she has a spot. She always has a portion of the sign-up sheet dedicated to her "wait list" as you never know if a spot will open up due to a change in plans or illness, etc. Currently, the class fee is payable to her on the day of the class. If something changes in that regard, the Activities staff will communicate that to you at the time of sign up. She is also set up at the Country Store monthly and has a variety of her art for sale there. If you are looking for a special "one of a kind" unique gift, a mandala dot painted item fits the bill!!
