Name tags and guest passes— Are required to be worn in the park and for participation in park activities. Park activities with the exception of some special events i.e. dances are NOT OPEN to the public. ALL guests must wear a guest badge obtained from and returned to the main office when they leave, if after hours they may drop them in the drop box outside the Activity Office.

It has been noted that many outside residents have retained guests passes and continue to use them to access our activities, thereby limiting participation of our residents. Please note that the "WHITE GUEST PASSES" are expired and no longer valid. Guest passes when issued are now issued in varying colors and changed on a regular basis to make it easier for activity coordinators to determine validity of current passes.

Please be mindful of **blocking the street** with vehicles, please do not congregate in the middle of the street to visit on your golf carts, or double park vehicles, etc. The roadways must be kept clear for general travel, large campers, trailers, emergency vehicles, and to pass through.

DO NOT PULL into the trash area when the trash trucks are present in SD 1, this is difficult for the trash drivers to see you and causes a hazard to yourself and the trash truck as they try to maneuver in tight area.

Group Highlights

PING PONG -- Table tennis and ping-pong are essentially the same game and there are no major differences between them. The real difference, however, is one of perception. Table tennis is the serious, competitive side of the sport in which people compete in leagues and cup competitions across the world, as well as in international championships. Ping-pong is an almost identical game (although there are several variations, including the well-known game of beer pong, of course) that is played in a much more informal and social way. While not all might agree with these differences, many prefer to play the more social game of 'ping pong' and may make some slight adjustments. If you think you might enjoy playing Ping Pong, join the group on Monday evenings at 7 PM in the Hang out Room.


Shuffleboard -- Is a game in which players use cues to push weighted discs, sending them gliding down a narrow court, with the purpose of having them come to rest within a marked scoring area. The objective of the game is to slide, all four of one's Weights alternately against those of an opponent, so that they reach the highest scoring area without falling off the end of the board into the alley. Furthermore, a player's Weight(s) must be farther down the board than his opponent's Weight(s), in order to be in scoring position. This may be achieved either by knocking off the opponent's Weight(s), or by outdistancing them. Sundance has 10 shuffleboards located in SD 2 behind the pool, they meet M – W and F at 9:15 for organized play, and have beginner's shuffleboard at 11:30 AM on Mondays.
