It's been in the news that USPS - the post office is suspending mail to Canada due to the strike of the Canadian postal workers. The mail room will NOT be accepting any mail to Canada at

this time. If you have any mailings to go out during this time please try to contact those guests/residents by email or another method.

Why was my parcel returned or not delivered to my home? 😞

The park was recently advised by FedEx that they are continually having parcels addressed to 1703 N Thornton Rd without unit #'s. Up until 11/25/2024 they are being returned to the Fed Ex Office as incomplete address. Beginning on 1/26/2024 the drivers have been instructed that all parcels for 1703 N Thornton Rd without a unit # will be left outside of the main office door, as the driver does not arrive until after hours.

This address issue can also apply to UPS or USPS.
