Group/Activities Highlights & News

Hiking Group -- The Feb 4 hike will be to Sunset Vista Trail at Picacho Peak (about 30 miles south of us). We will hike between 4 and 5 miles around the south side of the mountain on an out and back trail. We will not be going to the top and will turn around as the trail gets steep. Meet in activity parking lot by 7:50 leave at 8am. Cost to enter Park is \$7 per car. No passes. Anyone wanting to do the full hike to the top needs to contact Mary Lou. Hikers should have proper hiking shoes as the Arizona rocks can be slippery. Water, sunscreen, hats and an energy snack or lunch are suggested. Riders will be asked to share gas cost to driver of minimum \$5 each.

What is Mah Jongg? NO! This is not that matchy-matchy game you play on your phone! Mah Jongg, a game that has transcended centuries, finds its roots in ancient China. Believed to have been created during the Qing Dynasty, this intricate game combines elements of skill, strategy, and calculation, with a subtle degree of chance. Traditionally, Mah Jongg was played with 144 tiles based on Chinese characters and symbols, and its allure has only grown with time. Mah Jongg is typically played by four players but can be played with three or even two; each taking turns to draw and discard tiles. The objective is to form a complete hand that matches one of the patterns on the playing card. Think of it like Rummy, only we use tiles instead of cards. Over time, Mah Jongg has diversified into numerous variations, each with its own unique twist on the traditional rules. We play two versions here in our park: **American Mah Jongg, played here in the park on Wednesday and Saturday at 1 PM in the Gambling Room – Coordinator: Velvet Talley** American Mah Jongg, is the place to start if you are new to the game. **Marvelous Mah Jongg, played here in the park on Monday at 10 AM in the Gambling Room – Coordinators: Jayne Neu and Lara Kinley.** Marvelous Mah Jongg is a great expansion on the American version and will take you to a new level of play. Although absolute beginners can start with this game, we always encourage new players to start with the traditional American version first. Whatever level you are; grand champion to absolute beginner we welcome you to come

play, explore and learn this fun game. We have cards for you to use while you learn and many patient teachers to help you along the way Again! This is not the matchy-matchy “concentration” game you may have seen online.

Ceramics shop –They got a late start as we recruited for a new room Coordinator, but up-stepped “Jean Bose”, who is doing a fantastic job, herself having had to learn how to use the kiln, where to buy greenware and bisque, all the different types of paints and supplies available, but she’s overcome those hurdles and has a team of monitors to help you. If you haven't been in the Ceramics shop you need to stop in and visit, you may become addicted like the rest of them! They have greenware, bisque and all products needed to complete a project, from start to finish. If you need help with a project, they have a monitor who can help with questions.

DID YOU KNOW

ICE MACHINE The Ice Machine is located in the outside hallway between the laundry room and the Hole in the Wall, as well as Sundance3 behind Pool2.

CHANGE MACHINE is located in the laundry room at Sundance1. The washing machines in the laundry room are HE models which require only a ¼ cup of liquid soap. If you use any more than that the soap will not get rinsed completely from clothes or it will cause the soap to spill out of the front of the washer onto to the floor causing a fall hazard. Pods should be placed directly into the tub. We also have a large capacity commercial washer now to wash your large item comforters. The price of washers and dryers is \$2.00/load.

While using the pools please remember...

- Cover-ups are required for both women and men when you are outside of the fenced pool areas.
- Make sure you towel off before leaving the pool so your drips don't create a fall hazard.
- Don't enter any room or building with wet swim attire, Yes, someone has done that 😞
- Remember that pool shoes are fine in the pool, but shouldn't be worn as street shoes. By wearing pool shoes to and from the pools, the debris that is on the bottom of the shoes will end up in our sparkling pools and could possibly damage the filtering equipment.
- Shower and rinse off body oils and soap residue before entering the pool – both pools have outdoor showers, (Not to be used for personal hygiene – yes we've seen that too!) 😊 😞
- Bathing attire needs to be thoroughly rinsed well after being washed as soap will collect in the fabric and will end up in the pool and especially in the hot tubs. (HMMM didn't know this....) This in turn requires additional maintenance to the hot tub.

If you are out and about the park at night, please make sure that your golf cart and bicycles are properly lit. Walkers, please carry a flashlight so you can be seen in the dark.
