Hiking Group is going to Sabino Canyon on **MONDAY**. You must sign-up TODAY Friday, Feb 28th so tickets can be purchased for the Tram. "This week's Monday (March 3rd) hike will be going to Sabino Canyon Recreation Area in North Tucson(70* miles). **Meet in the activity parking lot by 7:30, leave at 7:45. Catch tram at 10am.**

The group will ride the tram up the canyon (\$15) and then hike about 5 + miles and another 600 or so feet of elevation to get back to the trailhead. The trail is described as narrow along the canyon wall with a few drop offs and rocky in places. If you are afraid of heights this is not the hike for you. Tram tickets will need to be pre-brought, -- sign up in activities by 3:30pm TODAY Friday, Feb 28th, and you will pay MaryLou \$15 on Monday. If you miss the deadline but want to go you can buy your own tickets if availability exists. Hikers should have proper hiking shoes as the Arizona rocks can be slippery. Water, sunscreen, hats and an energy snack are suggested. Riders will be asked to share gas cost to driver of \$5 or more each. Cost of tram is \$15 each.



Need to report a burned out street light in your neighborhood? Make a note of these numbers on the light pole or take a picture and report it to Maintenance with the street name.

Reservation Dates for 2025-2026

All reservations for 3 months or longer REQUIRE A \$200 deposit. (This includes RV Annuals – or you run the risk of your site being booked).

All Storage Reservations Require a \$50 Deposit

All Storage Deposits are NON REFUNDABLE

If you are keeping your storage for next season you will need to put down a \$50 deposit.
Or you risk the chance of losing your storage site.

February 10st -21th – Reservations are available only if you have a 3 month or longer reservation this season AND are making a 3 month or longer reservation for next season on the same site.

February 24th – March 7th – Reservations are available for anyone who is making a 3 month or longer reservation for next season and must include January, February and March. (ex. If you book 5 months it must include Jan, Feb and March.)

March 10th – Reservations still 3 months or longer must include at least one of the following months. Jan, Feb or March.

The front desk will not be taking requests for site preferences ----
All reservations are on a first come basis

July 1, 2025 Open Reservations for any length of time

RV Annuals are the only reservations that 100% guarantee their site.

Reservations for 4 months or longer, your site is guaranteed to not change 30 days prior to your reservation due to setting up electric in your name.

All reservations are guaranteed a site but not a particular site.

Refund Policy A \$50 dollar cancellation fee if cancelled a minimum of 30 days prior to the start of reservation EXCEPT if cancellation is made after Oct 1st. Any cancellation made after October 1st Thru March 31st is NON-REFUNDABLE.

JUST A FRIENDLY REMINDER....If you are a RV annual and would like your site for next year, please come into the office and put your \$200 deposit down or you could be in jeopardy of losing it.
